

Basic Life Support Health Care Provider (BLS)

The BLS Provider course is designed for a healthcare provider who would respond to victims in cardiac arrest individually or as part of a team. Through an interactive four hour course, students will be engaged by video based demonstration, group discussions and active participation in simulated cases. By the completion of this course, students will be able to apply BLS concepts to the Chain of Survival, recognize the signs of an individual requiring CPR, and perform high-quality CPR for adults, children and infants. BLS Provider certifications are valid for two (2) years from the date of the course.

HeartCode Basic Life Support (BLS)

After completing the eLearning component, students will attend a structured Instructor-led course that focuses on meaningful skills practice, debriefing, team scenarios, discussions of local protocols and skills testing. By the completion of this course, students will be able to apply BLS concepts to the Chain of Survival, recognize the signs of an individual requiring CPR, and perform high-quality CPR for adults, children and infants. BLS Provider certifications are valid for two (2) years from the date of the course.

Policy for American Heart Association (AHA), Emergency Nursing Association (ENA), and American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) certifications follows:

AHA certification: ACLS, BLS, PALS

- Within 7 days of course-nonrefundable or may reschedule to first available Training Center date
- Within 8-14 days of course-75% refundable or may reschedule to first available Training Center date
- Canceling 15+ days-refund minus administration fee of \$25 or may reschedule to first available Training Center date

ENA certification: TNCC, ENPC

- Within 30 days of course-nonrefundable or may reschedule to first available Training Center date
- Within 45 days of course-75% refundable or may rescheduled to first available Training Center date
- Within 60 days of course-refund minus administration fee of \$25 or may reschedule to first available Training Center date
